## Master's degree

Upon completing the required credits in the master program of the Graduate School of Economics, submitting a master's thesis following research guidance and presentation at the Mid-term Presentation session, and passing the final examination, candidates will be recognized as having acquired a comprehensive understanding of economics, advanced specialization, and the ability to address policy issues. Accordingly, they will be conferred the degree of "Master of Arts in Economics".

## **Doctoral degree**

Upon completing the required credits in the Doctoral program of the Graduate School of Economics, submitting a doctoral dissertation following research guidance and presentation at the Dissertation Public Defense, and passing the final examination, candidates will be recognized as having acquired independent research skills in Economics. Accordingly, they will be conferred the degree of PhD in Economics.
